LIVING THE LITURGY

Jesus was sent into the world to show humanity what God wanted and was offering. **IN THE HOLY WEEK SCRIPTURES** We see that while in Jerusalem the same thing happened as did throughout his life and mission: many people opposed him and some became his disciples.

In this week we remember his completion of his work of service from God:

- ◇ Welcomed and acclaimed as Christ, the servant of God to renew humanity
- ◇ Ending the old ways of religion and starting the new, cleansing the temple
- ◇ Giving us the gift of "worship in Spirit and in Truth" as the Father wanted
- ◇ His complete obedience even in the face of his arrest, condemnation and crucifixion by the established powers of religion and state
- ◇ His mission shown to be a great victory, through his Resurrection and appearance in Divine Glory

We his disciples who give flesh to God in our world, make Holy Week a spiritual time—as if we were there at Jesus' Passion and Resurrection.

THE COVERED STATUES is a Catholic custom to add intensity to our experience by focusing on JESUS ONLY this week...laying aside our other devotions to join our prayer to the work only Jesus could do for us.

OUR PALM CROSSES are a traditional sign of connection and faith with the loving sacrifice of Jesus for us in this week: do take them home and give them a valued place in your home.

THE SACRED TRIDUUM

These "3 Days" begin each evening until the following evening:

MAUNDY THURSDAY begins our sacred time at 7.00pm with

- ◇ the Last Supper Mass
- ◇ The sharing in the Humble Service as Christ's disciples
- ◇ The gift of the priesthood
- ◇ Then "Watching in the Garden" at the altar of repose after until 10pm

GOOD FRIDAY

At 11am is the traditional Ecumenical Witness at St Mary's in West Derby.

THE LITURGY OF THE PASSION at 3.00pm is when we all join together to appreciate and worship:

- ◇ God giving his life for us in Jesus
- ◇ Our thanksgiving through Veneration of the Cross and communion
- ◇ Proclaiming the Passion Gospel and the Prayer of the Church for all humanity

Meditation at the Tomb at 7.00pm in the evening is a quiet, prayer time with music and scriptures. Well worth it.

HOLY SATURDAY is a quiet day with no formal liturgy, but we welcome all the Polish Catholics for their **Swieconka at 1pm:** blessing of Easter foods for home prayer together.

Soulcare Meditation/Centering Prayer in the house from 11am to 2.00pm

THE EASTER VIGIL on Saturday evening, begins at 8.00pm in church and is

- ◆ the annual celebration of our own **spiritual journeys so far.....**
- ◆ **Recalling** God's action throughout History leading up to our practise of the faith
- ◆ **We all renew our sharing in the Resurrection Spirit** through Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.
- ◆ **Our newly chosen in the RCIA** make their commitment to be Catholic disciples with the sacraments, and are joyfully received.

EASTER SUNDAY MASS is at 10.00am as usual with a joyful welcome to all families....and with a little gift for the children.

EASTERTIDE IS 50 DAYS following on from the Holy Week and the Easter Triduum. The special Sunday masses tell of the Risen Christ with his disciples and guiding them in the new ways of faith. The Easter gift of the Holy Spirit is nurtured in our lives like the first disciples, and this is also a special time for the new Catholics, growing in appreciation of the mysteries of our faith. We lead up to the celebration of the Spirit in our lives as Pentecost on May 24th

HOLY COMMUNION FAMILIES

It is great that all join us this Sunday for the Palm Sunday and procession, after the latest Saturday catechesis sessions.

Please make sure you know clearly:

- ◆ The date and time of your child's First Holy Communion mass
- ◆ AND the date and time of the rehearsal for that mass which you **must** come to.

The children's communions are a lovely part of Eastertide for us all, for the prayer partners and families.
