### LIVING THE LITURGY

**Pentecost** proclaims the Promise of God fulfilled. All throughout all history all God's actions among his people aroused the appetite for more: a feeling of promise that there is always more to come!

**Jesus was the fulfilment of the Promise** of Saviour, Messiah and at the completion of his role in God's saving work he himself made a Promise: another, even the very Spirit of God that was in him!

**Receiving this Holy Spirit from God** is the culmination of faith in the history of God and the Revelation of Jesus.

**Living with this Holy Spirit from God** is the way of life a Christian enters into at Baptism, at whatever age.

**Growing into life in this Holy Spirit** is the blessing of a life of faith, life which bears fruit in knowing love, joy, peace, patience kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control.

**In the weeks following this crowning fest of our Church's life** we will continue to ask the Spirit to nurture in us as a parish, to birth within us as disciples, the fruits and gifts that Christians have witnessed to over centuries of people living in the Spirit of Christ. Today we celebrate God's Promise consummated, and join the Benedictus prayer author in praising God and asking to keep growing:

**Your love for our Fathers is fulfilled and your holy Covenant remembered. You swore to Abraham our Father to grant us that, free from fear, and saved from the hands of our foes, we might serve you in holiness and justice all the days of our life in your Presence**

### HOLY SPIRIT NURTURING HOLINESS
