LIVING THE LITURGY

We continue in our Pentecost attitude praying for the Holy Spirit to nurture within us the fruits of the Spirit and the services we can offer.

The Spirit is given; it is done....the Spirit has come down, sent by God for us...and accompanies us in daily living, waiting for our willingness, consenting, to act within us. So "Come Holy Spirit" is a prayer for Come UP Holy Spirit....welling up within us like a fountain of living water

TRINITY SUNDAY today is a celebration of how God's love comes to us, how God has shown himself to humanity:

- ⇒ God "out there", "up there", in the Heavens, the creator we name as Father, ever transcendent and mystery
- ⇒ God other than ourselves teaching and communicating to us - via Church, others, nature—we call God the Son
- ⇒ God within us, mysterious presence influencing us from within - mind and heart and attitudes— we call God the Holy Spirit

These 3 ways of being God always act together in Unity, so we say they are "3 in 1"....and "they " are like a community of love drawing us into that union. This love for us is the push towards and energy to help us into finding ways to improve in Holy Living, a practical holiness of down to earth life

" You grant us that , free from fear, and saved from the hands of our foes, we might serve you in holiness and justice all the days of our life in your Presence
