**In today's Scriptures** we see the calling of God for people to share in his love and share it out with others. God is love....and this means work, as anyone who knows love knows!

We are all called to recognize the gifts of God in life, to respond with gratitude, and join with others to build community. So in the exodus reading the people of God are called together to holy living, with common care for each other, shared values and customs.
