LIVING THE LITURGY

The Scriptures today continue the teaching of Jesus, again this week, on how we are to continue the mission of Christ:

- ◆ **To share in** the love and gifts of His Holy Spirit
- ◆ **To share out** this love in service in the parish and witness in the world

He is frank and open that, like him, we will face some kind of opposition, rejection, maybe mockery or being ignored.

HAVE NO FEAR Jesus urges us. Easier said than done, but conquering fear in many forms is part of maturing in faith. Fear comes from others outside us, and our own make up inside us! Courage is needed to live, and tell others, the faith:but often there is not enough to make us fearless.

Only deeper and deeper love will transform our fearing: this is the teaching of Christ. Knowing our worth— realizing how valuable we are to God—feeling it, receiving it, so we accept the Spirit's gift of self-esteem...only then, and step by step, will our faith grow stranger than our fears

And we can live bravely:

- ◆ What God asks of us
- ◆ To let others know Catholic faith is precious
- ◆ And practise our Catholic principles and values even when others don't

Growing in affection and support for each other in the parish is a great way of growing in faith stronger than fears.
